Adelaide & North Road Water Main Improvements City of Fenton

The Phase 1 Adelaide Street water main installation is nearly complete from South Holly to Silver Lake Road. The road construction phase of the project has already begun. Over the next several weeks (starting October 18) the concrete curb repairs and sidewalk replacements will take place. During this time, access to driveways will be prohibited for several days while the concrete cures. The contractor will attempt to contact homeowners to coordinate driveway closures. Homeowners affected by the installation of new concrete should start to make arrangements to seek alternate parking locations at a neighbor's driveway or adjacent side streets.

After the concrete has been installed, the roadway will be prepped for installation of the new pavement. During the time roadway work is being performed in front of driveways, access will be temporarily prohibited for several hours. We know this will be an inconvenience but we do appreciate your patience during this process.
