Silver Parkway Resurfacing City of Fenton

The City of Fenton has secured \$1.28 million through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) to rehabilitate Silver Parkway, from Owen Road to Silver Lake Road. The remaining driveway work will take place beginning the week of April 5, 2010. Also, at this time the temporary traffic crossovers will be put into use to maintain two way traffic during road construction. Traffic will be shifted to the southbound side of the Parkway allowing for two way traffic (one lane each direction) throughout the project. The speed limit will be reduced to 25 mph within the construction zone. The northbound side will be milled and overlaid, along with base repairs and minor drainage improvements during the first phase of construction. After this work is done, the process will be reversed and paving will be started on the northbound side.

During the time of construction access to driveways may be temporarily prohibited. Access to each site will be maintained through parking lot interconnections and adjacent driveways. We appreciate your patience during this process.
