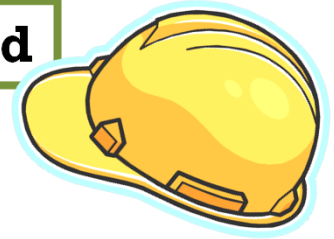

### The City of Wixom 2010 Road Maintenance Program Wexford Mews

As part of the City's annual road maintenance program, road repairs will be made within the Wexford Mews Subdivision. This work is scheduled to begin in early June and completion of the roadwork is anticipated by Labor Day. In Phases One and Two of the development, the work will consist of removing and replacing the existing asphalt pavement and base material, with limited curb & gutter repairs and minor storm sewer improvements.

Point repairs will be made to the existing sanitary sewer in four different isolated areas within the subdivision. The existing sidewalk ramps at all intersections will be reconstructed to meet ADA compliance. In Phase Three, the existing pavement will be milled and receive a 1.5 inch asphalt overlay, with limited repairs made to the existing base. 2-way traffic will be maintained at all times, but delays may occur. Some driveways may be closed temporarily as repairs are being made. We ask for your patience during this construction project.
