Rochester/Big Beaver Intersection and Park Improvements

The City of Troy, Oakland County, Michigan, will receive bids at the office of the City Clerk, 500 W. Big Beaver Road, Troy, Michigan 48084, up to 10:00 a.m. local time on Wednesday, May 6, 2009 for "ROCHESTER/BIG BEAVER INTERSECTION AND PARK IMPROVEMENTS", after which they will be publicly opened and read.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The Contract will consist of the aesthetic improvements at the intersection of Rochester Road and Big Beaver Road and Park construction at the northeast corner of the intersection. The project is broken into two Divisions of work by the type of work involved as follows: Division I – Rochester/Big Beaver Intersection Improvements and Park Grading; and Division II – Park Construction and Park/Right of Way Landscaping. Included in the Division I project is the removal of roadway pavement for the installation of colored concrete crosswalks, ADA compliant crosswalk ramps with pedestrian pushbuttons, roadway pavement removal for installation of a center boulevard island, concrete sidewalk/concrete unit paver removal and replacement, pond expansion within the park, concrete modular retaining wall installation within the park, miscellaneous storm drainage modifications within the park and rough grading of the park site. Included in the Division II project is final grading within the park, park and right of way landscape plantings, right of way irrigation system modifications, concrete unit paver installation, decorative fencing installation, miscellaneous park site furniture, park lighting system and park irrigation system.

Each of the project Divisions is included in one bid package due to the need for the work to be coordinated between the contractors. One or both of the project Divisions may be bid by a single contractor but submitting a bid for both Divisions is not a requirement. The City may choose to award to a single contractor or to separate contractors at their discretion.

The Contract will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the contract drawings:

Big Beaver Road, Troy, Michigan and also at Construction Association of Michigan, Dodge Reports and Daily Construction Reports. Copies may be obtained on Wednesday, April 15, 2009 at the office of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. located at 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360. A non-refundable charge of forty five (\$45.00) Dollars, payable by check to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., will be made for each set. An additional twenty (\$20.00) Dollars will be charged for each set mailed. The Contractor is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Contractor must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

The proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or a cashier's check in the following amount: **\$25,000.00**. **NO BID BONDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Checks shall be made payable to the City of Troy. See Proposal Section for additional bid deposit information if Bidder elects to submit a bid for both Divisions. The bid deposit of the successful bidder shall be forfeited if he fails to execute a contract and supply the required bonds and insurance within thirty (30) calendar days after the award. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after receipt of the bids.

The City reserves the right to accept any bids or reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in any bid in the best interest of the City. Bids will be rejected for the following reasons:

- a) If the proposal does not contain a unit price for each item listed, except when there is only one unit of work; or
- b) If the bidder adds any provision reserving the right to accept or reject an award or to enter into a contract pursuant to an award.

No proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the City Clerk on or before 10:00 a.m. local time, Wednesday, May 6, 2009.
