Sealed proposals for the construction of the City of Fenton Pump Station Improvements will be received by City Clerk for the City of Fenton, until **10:00 a.m., Local Time on Wednesday, July 1, 2009**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

Construction of four (4) new duplex, submersible sanitary pumping stations and concrete valve chambers, including valves, piping and all other associated mechanical and electrical appurtenances.

Approximately 500 ft. of HPDE force main via horizontal directional drilling.

Approximately 360 ft. of Ductile Iron force main.

Replacement of two (2) submersible pumps at an existing pumping station, including all mechanical and electrical appurtenances.

Supply and installation of seven (7) packaged natural gas emergency power generators.

Supply and installation of a new SCADA system at seven (7) pump station sites plus control center.

Maintaining operation of the existing pumping station during construction.

Miscellaneous demolition and restoration.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms shall be available on or after June 1, 2009 at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of One Hundred and Five (\$105.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to** "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping-and-handling charge of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

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Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Fenton in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Fenton. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least One Hundred and Twenty (120) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City of Fenton reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.
