The City of Troy, Oakland County, Michigan, will receive bids at the office of the City Clerk, 500 W. Big Beaver Road, Troy, Michigan 48084, up to 10:00 a.m. local time on Tuesday, September 22, 2009 for "SCADA SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS", after which they will be publicly opened and read.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The Contract will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the contract drawings:

SCADA System Improvements at the DPW Building..... Lot  
PRV RTU and Pressure Transmitters Replacement..... 11 Locations  
Pressure Monitoring Point RTU and Pressure Transmitter Replacement..... 4 Locations  
Sanitary Pump Station RTU Replacement..... 6 Locations  
Sanitary Pump Station New RTU..... 1 Location  
Sanitary Pump Station Pump Controls Replacement ..... 7 Locations  
DPW Existing Control Panel Demolition and Wall Closure ..... Lot  
And Miscellaneous Items of Removal, Construction and Restoration, as set forth in the Proposal.

**ATTENTION:**

Plans and specifications, under which work is to be done, are on file and may be examined at the Engineering Office, Troy City Hall, 500 W. Big Beaver Road, Troy, Michigan and also at Construction Association of Michigan, Dodge Reports and Daily Construction Reports. Copies may be obtained on Monday, August 31, 2009 at the office of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. located at 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360. A non-refundable charge of forty five (\$45.00) Dollars, payable by check to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., will be made for each set. An additional ten (\$10.00) Dollars will be charged for each set mailed. The Contractor is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Contractor must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

The proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or a cashier's check in the following amount: **\$25,000.00.** **NO BID BONDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Checks shall be made payable to the City of Troy. The bid deposit of the successful bidder shall be forfeited if he fails to execute a contract and supply the required bonds and insurance within thirty (30) calendar days after the award. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after receipt of the bids.

The City reserves the right to accept any bids or reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in any bid in the best interest of the City. Bids will be rejected for the following reasons:

- a) If the proposal does not contain a unit price for each item listed, except when there is only one unit of work;
- b) If the Proposal does not provide all the Information requested on Bidder's Qualifications and Experience; or
- c) If the bidder adds any provision reserving the right to accept or reject an award or to enter into a contract pursuant to an award.

Each properly submitted Proposal shall be Evaluated and Scored, as described in the Proposal Document, and if accepted, the Contract Award shall be made to the Vendor having the highest Averaged Score in the Evaluations of the Proposals.

No proposal will be received unless made on forms furnished in the Contract Documents and delivered to the City Clerk on or before 10:00 a.m. local time, Tuesday, September 22, 2009.
