

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
SQUARE LAKE ROAD
WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT
BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP**

Sealed proposals for the construction of the Square Lake Road Water Main Replacement Project will be received by the Clerk for the Township of Bloomfield, until 10:00 a.m., Local Time on Wednesday, April 22, 2009, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms shall be available on or after Monday, April 6, 2009 at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of Seventy-Five (\$75.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to** "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the Township of Bloomfield in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide

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assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the Township. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on Monday, April 13, 2009 at 10:00 am at Bloomfield Township Hall for all prospective bidders.

All bidders must meet the requirements set forth in the Township's prequalification statement. The Owner will require at least three (3) satisfactory municipal references for similar work in the last two (2) years contracts with a value of greater than \$50,000.00. The Township intends to award the contract to a qualified pipe bursting contractor, meeting the prequalification requirements as outlined in the project specifications. Only qualified pipe bursting contractors, submitting bids as the prime contractor, shall be considered.

The Township reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the Township Clerk on or before 10:00 a.m., Local time, April 22, 2009.
