

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
CHESTER STREET STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS
CITY OF SOUTH LYON
OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

Sealed proposals for the construction of the Chester Street Storm Sewer Improvements will be received by the City Clerk for the City of South Lyon, 335 South Warren, South Lyon, Michigan 48178, until 2:30 p.m., Local Time on July 7, 2009, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The project consists of the removal and replacement of the existing deteriorated storm sewer located in Chester Street between Chester Ct. and Woodland Drive. The work also includes upgrading the pavement cross-section on Chester Street at the same location.

The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City Clerk in the amount of five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of South Lyon. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City of South Lyon reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the City Clerk on or before 2:00 p.m., Local time, July 7, 2009.
