

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
DISINFECTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS
WARREN, MICHIGAN**

Sealed bids for the construction of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Disinfection System Improvements will be received by the Division of Purchasing for the City of Warren, located at One City Square, 4th Floor, Warren, MI 48093-5289, until 12:30 pm local time on Thursday, November 12, 2009. **The original and three (3) additional copies of the bid form must be submitted.** Bids will be transported to the City Council Chambers Auditorium at the Warren Community Center, 5460 Arden, Warren, Michigan and publicly opened and read at 1:00 PM.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for receipt will not be accepted or will be marked late and retained unopened. Bids submitted without a signature will be rejected.

The Contract shall consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The work consists of construction of new ultraviolet and sodium hypochlorite disinfection systems to replace the existing chlorine gas system. Demolition of the existing chlorine system is also included. Major work items include a new Disinfection Building and associated influent structure, 24" non-potable water supply line, 60" final effluent sewer, and a new sodium hypochlorite storage and feed system.

The project will be financed with assistance from the State of Michigan Revolving Funds using Federal assistance authorized by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The ARRA requirements include compliance with the Davis Bacon Act, adherence to the current U.S. Department of Labor Wage Decision and adherence to the "Buy American" policy.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Bid Forms may be secured on or after Monday, October 12, 2009 at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of One Hundred Thirty (\$130.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to** "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting and site tour will be held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, Conference Room, 32360 Warkop Ave., Warren, Michigan on October 27, 2009, at 9:00 a.m. local time. Attendance is required for prospective bidders.

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Bids submitted by Contractors who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid shall be submitted on the bid forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Warren in the amount of five percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Bid Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Warren. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City of Warren reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Bid will be received unless made on bid forms furnished and delivered to the Division of Purchasing on or before 12:30 pm, local time, Thursday, November 12, 2009.
