Sealed proposals for the construction of Chapaton Retention Treatment Basin Improvements, Dry Weather Pump & Wet Well Segmentation, will be received by Macomb County Public Works Commissioner Anthony V. Marrocco, on behalf of the 8½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage Board, Owner, 21777 Dunham Road, Clinton Township, Michigan 48036 until **10 a.m. on November 24, 2009**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project includes **installation of a dry well submersible sewage pump, construction of a concrete divider wall within the existing wet well structure, installation of ductile iron piping, magnetic flow meters, valves, and other miscellaneous equipment and appurtenances.**

A non-reimbursable check payable to **Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.**, in the amount of \$150 must be deposited for each set of documents. Bid documents may be obtained by overnight delivery service for an additional fee of \$50 in the form of a non-reimbursable check made payable to **Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.**

A certified check or bank draft payable without condition to the Macomb County Treasurer or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company in an amount of 5% of the proposal amount shall be submitted with each bid as a guarantee of good faith. Bids are to be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked **“Chapaton Pump Station Improvements - Dry Weather Pump & Wet Well Segmentation”**.

A MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING will be held at the project site, located at 23001 E. 9 Mile Road, St. Clair Shores, Michigan at **9 a.m. on October 29, 2009**. **All bidders must attend the pre-bid meeting.** An attendance sheet will be executed at the pre-bid meeting to verify attendance. Only bids received from contractors in attendance at the pre-bid meeting will be opened. All other bids will be rejected as non-responsive. Minutes of the pre-bid meeting will be made part of the contract documents for the project. Contingent upon the availability of State Revolving Funds, the Notice to Proceed will be issued no later than February 17, 2010. The right to accept any proposal, to reject any or all proposals and to waive defects in the proposals is reserved by the Owner.
