Sealed proposals for the construction of the 2009 Joint and Crack Sealing Program will be received by the Village Clerk for the Village of Franklin, 32325 Franklin Road, Franklin, Michigan 48025 until 10:00 a.m., Local Time on Wednesday, September 9, 2009, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

Lateral, longitudinal, and random joints and cracks at various locations throughout the Village are to be routed, cleaned, and sealed and paid as the following bid items:

Rout, clean, and seal cracks and joints	18,000 lft
Hot poured sealant	6,000 lbs

A non-refundable payment of Forty-Five (\$45.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc."** will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Contractors who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the Village in the amount of Five Percent (5 %) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the Village. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

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The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The Village reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the Village Clerk on or before 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, September 9 2009.
