

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
2010 SAFETY PATH PROGRAM
BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP, MICHIGAN**

Sealed proposals for the construction of the 2010 Safety Path Program will be received by the Township Clerk for Bloomfield Township, 4200 Telegraph Road, Bloomfield Hills, MI, until **10:00 a.m., Local Time on April 14, 2010**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

Construct approximately 145,000 sft of 4 inch, 6 inch and 8 inch thick concrete safety path and drive approaches, with approximately 4,500 sft of Keystone retaining wall, 72 lft of wooden pedestrian bridge and 2,750 lft of concrete curb, plus miscellaneous ditching and drainage as necessary, on Long Lake Road, Franklin Road, Square Lake Road, Telegraph Road, and Woodward Avenue in Bloomfield Township.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms may be secured on or after Thursday, April 1, 2010 at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of Seventy Five (\$75.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc."** will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for shipping and handling charge of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY**, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Contractors who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the Township Clerk in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the Township. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

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The Township reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the Township Clerk on or before 10:00 a.m., Local time, April 14, 2010.
