Sealed proposals for the construction of the Sludge Storage Tank Repairs will be received by the South Huron Valley Utility Authority (SHVUA), SHV Wastewater Treatment Plant, 34001 W. Jefferson Ave., Brownstown, Michigan 48173 until **2:00 p.m., Local Time on Tuesday August 31, 2010**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

**Description of Work**

Repairs to the 4 million gallon sludge storage tank include structural repairs to the precast columns and beams, temporary shoring and bracing, repairs to precast deck and a new concrete deck topping with reinforcing steel, perimeter soil stabilization using geogrid and drainage tile, and miscellaneous site work and piping and valves.

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shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

**Proposal Guarantee**

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the bid forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the South Huron Valley Utility Authority in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Bid Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract within the hold period. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least 180 days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The Owner reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

**Award of Contract**

The South Huron Valley Utility Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, select the successful qualified bidder, and to waive any informality or irregularities in bidding should it consider same to be in its best interest. The successful qualified bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, labor and material bonds, maintenance and guarantee bond and insurance policies.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

**Pre-Bid Meeting**

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the South Huron Valley Wastewater Treatment Plant, 34001 West Jefferson Avenue, Brownstown Township, Michigan, on **Tuesday, August 17, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.** local time. Representatives of the Owner and the Consulting Engineers will be present to discuss the Project. Bidders are encouraged to attend and participate in the meeting. Failure to attend the meeting shall not relieve the bidder from knowledge and compliance with all other information and requirements referenced in the Contract Documents. **Tuesday, August 24, 2010, 8:00 AM to 10:00** is reserved for follow-up inspections by potential bidders, if desired. Bidders will not be able to enter the tank.
