

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
LOW & HIGH SERVICE PUMPS REPLACEMENT
CITY OF GROSSE POINTE FARMS

Sealed proposals for the Low & High Service Pump Replacement at the Farms' Water Plant will be received by the City Clerk for the City of Grosse Pointe Farms until 2:00 p.m., Local Time on Tuesday, August 24, 2010, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The City is seeking bids from qualified contractors to provide pump upgrades to their existing Water Treatment Facility (WTF). Currently, the WTF has three (3) low service, or low lift pumps that intake water from the WTF's booster station, adjacent to Lake St. Clair and five (5) high service, or high lift, pumps that are utilized for water distribution through their system. The project's scope includes the removal of the three (3) low service pumps and one (1) of the high service pumps and replacing them with new, larger-capacity low service and high service pumps, respectively. Each of the four (4) pumps will be listed as a separate Division of work. Further, there will be two (2) additional Divisions of work that includes the removal and replacement of the generator voltage regulator and the replacement of the IC control panel. The Bidder shall provide costs for each of the aforementioned Divisions of work in order to have their bid considered responsive and valid. The costs associated with each Division shall be listed and also included in the Total Amount of Bid for the overall project. The Owner reserves the right to award either a single Division, a combination of Divisions, or all Divisions and will decide after the bids are opened, depending upon the availability of funds.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms shall be available on or after Wednesday, August 4, 2010 at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of Seventy-Five (\$75.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to** "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check or cashier's check, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Grosse Pointe Farms in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. **NO BID BONDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Grosse Pointe Farms. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City of Grosse Pointe Farms reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the City Clerk on or before 2:00 p.m., Local Time on Tuesday, August 24, 2010.

There will also be a pre-bid meeting held at the Grosse Pointe Farms City Hall on **Tuesday, August 17, 2010 at 2:00 pm.** This pre-bid meeting will not be considered mandatory; however it shall be noted that this will be the best opportunity for prospective bidders to ask specific questions to the City's Water Plant Supervisor and the City's Engineers regarding the project as well as the existing condition and configuration of the Water Plant.
