Silver Parkway Resurfacing City of Fenton

The City of Fenton has secured \$1.28 million through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) to rehabilitate Silver Parkway, from Owen Road to Silver Lake Road. Some driveway work will take place this year (weather permitting), beginning the week of October 26 and ending in November. The sidewalk ramps at approaches will also be reconstructed to meet the current standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Also at this time, traffic crossovers will be installed to maintain traffic during the road construction next year. Beginning next Spring, the roadway will be milled and overlaid, along with some base repairs and minor drainage improvements.

During the time that driveways are being removed and replaced, access will be temporarily prohibited. The driveways will be reconstructed in multiple phases, to maintain access to each site through parking lot interconnections and adjacent driveways. We appreciate your patience during this process.
